- 4. If at any time you change your doctrinal beliefs and/or find disagreement with the official programs and policies of the Alliance you must notify the Chairperson of the L&O immediately.
- 5. Are you personally committed to the Statement Faith of The Christian and Missionary Alliance? YES/NO. If no explain.
