THE ALLIANCE STORY

The Alliance Churches of New Zealand is a *Christ Centred, Bible Believing, Spirit Filled, Missional Movement of Local Churches* who are committed to building healthy churches throughout New Zealand and supporting Alliance Missions worldwide.

Our story began in 1887, with the Canadian Presbyterian Minister, Dr A.B. Simpson who had a vision to help Christians grow deeper in their relationship with God, and to reach out with the gospel at home and overseas. After moving to New York City he successfully established an independent church and two interdenominational organisations to promote this vision and after his death these ministries merged to become The Christian & Missionary Alliance. The Alliance today is still committed to the deeper life with Christ and worldwide missions. We are united by the Alliance World Fellowship and have ministry in almost 90 countries; with 22,000 churches and 6.3 million members speaking 180 languages and dialects.

The Alliance was invited to New Zealand by a group of church leaders who believed our nation needed to strengthen its evangelical emphasis. The first service was held in 1972 in Mt Roskill and the first building was opened in Blockhouse Bay in 1974. We now have 9 churches across Auckland consisting of Cantonese, Mandarin, Korean, Vietnamese and Multicultural congregations. We also enjoy fellowship with Pastor Farid & Angela Shehata from the Middle Eastern Evangelical Church in Manurewa and Pastor Nigel & Mana Ripley from the Burwood Christian Centre in Christchurch.

The Alliance New Zealand has a Kingdom vision and we are active members in the Auckland Church Leaders Group, Auckland Prayer Breakfast, InterChurch Bureau, National Church Leaders Group, and the NZ Christian Network.

Internationally, we support 8 Global Partners serving in a variety of ministries in Tonga, Thailand, Philippines, India and Asia. To find out more, please contact us.


